

# *ECUADOR – 10 DAYS*

## **DAY 1. QUITO.**

Transfer in to the Hotel. Welcome cóctel and briefing. Dinner and rest.

## **DAY 2. QUITO – LAGO AGRIO – EL PUENTE**

Flight (09:15 a.m.) to Lago Agrio. Drive from Lago Agrio to El Puente. Canoe ride down the Cuyabeno River to our Lodge. Introduction of your tour guide and lunch. Explore the vegetation and animals during the exciting night walk.

## **DAY 3. CUYABENO RESERVE**

After breakfast we will paddle by a traditional dug-out canoe on the Caiman-Cocha Lake (Laguna Del Caiman) where we will enjoy the natural uniqueness. After lunch we'll take a hike in the primary forest including lessons on the use of plants for survival. Back to the Lodge.

## **DAY 4. CUYABENO RESERVE**

Morning walk to the Tarapuy Siona Community. Our naturalist guide will explain the culture and traditions of the native people. Lunch, Before we return to our camp, we'll have a relaxing time swimming and enjoying the sunset on the magnificent Laguna Grande Later that night we will take a canoe trip in search of caimans (alligators).

## **DAY 5. CUYABENO-LAGO AGRIO-QUITO**

Early morning bird watching. After breakfast: journey up the Cuyabeno River to El Puente. Drive to Lago Agrio. Flight back to Quito at 17:00. Dinner and rest.

## **DAY 6. QUITO-GALAPAGOS**

Departure to the Galapagos Enchanted Islands, arrival at Baltra airport, welcome by our park National guide, transfer to Santa Cruz. Lunch and afternoon visit to the Charles Darwin Research Station. Dinner and rest.

## **DAY 7. SANTA CRUZ**

Breakfast, visit to the beautiful TORTUGA BAY, unique in the world for its scenery, we can see marine iguanas and other species of animals, return to hotel / LUNCH. Afternoon visit to a private ranch, where "giant turtle" is found in natural habitat, and to complete the adventure, walk through an amazing tunnel lava. Return to hotel. Dinner

## **DAY 8. ISABELA**

Departure (after breakfast) at 08:00 am visit to the wetlands, lunch and visit the Center for Giant Tortoise Breeding, which is located 1.5 km from the town you can walk or drive. Here observe turtles of all ages can learn about the process of raising and breeding of giant turtles are considered endangered. From there we headed to the port to take lunch at a local restaurant. Then we snorkeling in Concha Perla, back to the hotel. dinner

## **DAY 9. GALAPAGOS-QUITO**

Breakfast in the hotel. Visit to Los Gemelos (the twins), fantastic volcanic formations where you can appreciate the lush vegetation of the island endemic. Occasionally you can see the bird witch. Transfer to Baltra's airport – Quito. Dinner and rest.

## **DAY 10. QUITO**

Breakfast, free morning and transfer out to Quito's airport International Departure.
